Services we usually offer will remain but may look different to what you're used to.

ASSESSMENTS FOR YOUNG CARERS AGED 18+ WILL BE PROVIDED BY SMBC*



From Monday 1st December 2025, we will no longer be providing carers assessments for carers aged 18-25. Instead, you will receive your assessment from Solihull council. An assessment helps identify and address your needs as a carer, leading to emotional and practical support, aimed at improving your wellbeing, physical and mental health, work, social life and helps identify benefits and support services for you. However, you can still access our service for ongoing support as normal. Ask us how to access your carers assessment!

DO YOU HAVE A CHILD WITH A DIAGNOSED DISABILITY OR ADDITIONAL NEED?

If 'yes' then you can get support for yourself too, by having a Parent Carers Assessment! This is a chance to talk about YOUR health, feelings, goals and more. By registering for this, you will receive your own carer's card, access to events and activities and a dedicated duty advice line, amongst other services.


